



manages a programme of training & support to youth and community groups to deliver these awards and accredit young people within their organisations.

Young Grant Making

Glasgow North East YouthBank is run and managed by Young Grant Makers these volunteers build their skills, knowledge and confidence whilst having a positive impact on their community. Young Grant Makers volunteer only 4 hours per month to managing the grant giving, YoMo offers full training and support to become a Young Grant Maker.

Peer Educator

Our Peer Educators support our Anti-Bullying programme which is delivered in schools and youth and community groups across the North East of Glasgow. Young People are trained in a Peer Education programme that was developed by a group of young people to tackle the issue of Bullying within schools and youth groups.

Young Leaders

Our young leaders programme support the development of YouthBank across the area by ensuring that the programme is youth led. Our young leaders support staff in the delivery of our Grant Giving nights, recruitment of new Young Grant Makers and Training of the Young Grant Makers.
